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Each manuscript is required to contain an abstract, clearly separated from the rest of the paper, which will be printed immediately after the title. In the footnote of the first page, the following information should be given: AMS subject classifications, key words and phrases. The affiliation(s) of the author(s) should be given at the end of the paper.

Formulas in the text should be written with the solidus or negative exponent; for example, a/b instead of  $\frac{a}{b}$  and  $(2a)^{-1}$  or 1/(2a) instead of  $\frac{1}{2a}$ . Also  $\sum_{i=1}^{n} a_i$  and  $\prod_{i=1}^{n} a_i$  should be used instead of  $\sum_{i=1}^{n} a_i$  and  $\prod_{i=1}^{n} a_i$ , respectively in the text.

References should be listed alphabetically in the following style:
